KBOO FINANCE COMMITTEE MONTHLY REPORT through March 2020

1. Are we on track to meet goal: Yes

Year-to-date through March 31, 2020 KBOO has spent \$57,131 less than budgeted on expenses. This savings came from having vacant staff positions and paying interim managers lower salary and no benefits.

As an overview, KBOO for 2020 has budgeted on average \$71,464 for expenses. In March total expenses were \$65, 932.
