Membership Drive Phone Test – KBOO Spring Membership Drive will begin Wednesday April 18 and end Monday April 30th. We need to test the drive phones before the install Tuesday afternoon April 17th. Discussion of BendTel phone outage resolution. We are still experiencing difficulty with international calls. Certain countries are on a no call list. Mike Johnson is working with Eric Wilson at BendTel to resolve this issue.

Inner City Blues Remote Broadcast – KBOO will be broadcasting the 7th annual Inner City Blues Festival "Healing the Health Care Blues" on Saturday April 21 from 5PM to Midnight. The event is at 7611 N Exeter Ave right off Lombard. Looking for crew. Please check in with Ani Haines if you would like to join the KBOO Remote Team and "Boogie Cat" Norman Sylvester for a fun evening of blues. ** Two volunteers are interested in joining the crew and attending the remote broadcast training session set for Thursday April 12th Studio One at 6PM-8PM.

Remote Broadcast Training – I have reserved Studio One next Thursday April 12th from 6-8PM to pull out and dust off our remote gear. This is a chance to test our equipment and pack it up before our load in for the Inner City Blues Festival. If you would like to find out more about how we pull off a remote broadcast, this is your opportunity.

New Clackamas Community College Intern – We have a new intern joining The Engineering Department starting next week. Intern will be involved in live music mixing, recording, audio editing, and remote broadcast production. Intern will be with us for 10 weeks.

HVAC at Studios and Tower Site – Reliable Mechanical has presented invoicing for services rendered at the tower during my absence. I was unaware that they had arranged to get access up there. Does anyone recall them doing a service call at the tower? We will also need service here at the studios this Spring before we hit the Summer heat. Do we want to continue with Reliable Mechanical for our HVAC service? ** Discussion of services rendered at the tower site. There was no service call at the tower site. We should not pay the invoice. Also, we seem to have a compressor issue on the KBOO studios roof. Reliable Mechanical has not made a service call at the KBOO studios for several months. The compressor issue on the roof needs to be addressed ASAP. Suggest we find another HVAC service.

Archiver 1 Logger Software – Archiver 1 is spitting out audio files with 0 file size. Rebooting the application did not fix anything. Suspect the hard drive has reached capacity and needs to have older audio deleted. Archiver 2 is fine. ** Hard drive does appear to be full. We will be deleting older audio files to regain storage space.

Live Music – Bluegrass band The Lil Smokies will be coming in Friday afternoon April 13th for a live set. Join us if you wish. Learn to mix audio or document for social media. ** Engineering Committee volunteer would like to bring video camera to document the live band.

Air Room Headphone Fix – Marc has a solution for the air room headphone distortion problem.

Allstream Accounting Issue – We discussed the AllStream T1 status. The T1 service was supposed to be canceled after the first 30 days of the new phone system installation. The T1 is no longer being used. MacRae is checking with Eric Wilson at BendTel to verify our understanding. The AllStream account will be canceled.

Larry Holtz – How will Larry's departure from All Classical affect KBOO Engineering? Can we ask for the microwave STL we used at the Blues Festival last year? It was the best STL solution we have ever had from that challenging site location. Discussion of situation at All Classical and how this may affect KBOO. Larry Holtz was in attendance and offered an update on the situation. Kipp offered insight concerning the All Classical Stonehenge Tower negotiations with KBOO. We are looking at other options for a station link during the Blues Festival. It is vital that we understand the current status of the All Classical/KBOO relationship.

90.7 FM Interference – A caller from Kalama, WA reports religious programming on 90.7 FM. I found a religious broadcaster in Baker City at 90.7 FM but they are way far away. ?? We await any further reports of interference because it is possible that there could be an illegal broadcaster on 90.7FM nearby.

Smoke Alarm Testing – We are scheduling a date for the smoke alarm test at the KBOO Studios.
